Parent–Club Partnership Agreement

This agreement outlines what parents can expect from the Germantown Girls Basketball Club (“GGBC” or “the Club”), and what the Club expects from parents in return. If a question or concern arises during your daughter’s time with the Club, we will refer back to this agreement. Each family signs this agreement once upon joining the Club; you will only be asked to sign again if the agreement is updated in a future year.

What You Can Expect From the Club

- Practices will be planned with the development of all players in mind.
- Girls will be placed on teams, but no player will be cut from the Club.
- Your daughter will be treated with respect at all times, including when being corrected by a coach.
- Communication from coaches and the Club will be timely, thorough, and open.
- No more than eight tournaments will be scheduled per season, unless team parents and coaches agree to schedule more.
- Your daughter will have the opportunity to participate in a league with regularly scheduled games.

What the Club Expects From You

- Participate in the Club’s culture of volunteerism. Needs may include, but are not limited to, scorekeeping, running the clock at games, working concessions at home tournaments, and staffing admission.
- Treat every player with respect, regardless of which team or uniform color she wears.
- Keep your daughter’s availability current on TeamSnap so coaches can plan practices and games accordingly.
- Follow the 24-hour rule: wait at least 24 hours after a game or practice before raising concerns about playing time, a player’s role on the team, or similar issues.
- Understand the difference between “correction” and “criticism,” and communicate accordingly.
- Support all members of the team, including the coaches, in your conduct in the stands.
- Refrain from criticizing or demeaning any child, on either team.
- Show respect toward game officials at all times.
